### GRCA APPROVED PLANT LIST

#### **POLICY SUMMARY**

##### **TREE REMOVAL:**

Gainey Ranch is an oasis in desert replete with mature trees, and we need to maintain that image. Therefore, the Master Architectural Committee has established guidelines for the removal of trees by a homeowner or an Association.

Each satellite community's architectural rules on trees should be considered and followed if need be, prior to removing trees.

The MAC tree removal guidelines are as follows:

- If it is diseased, dying or dead.
- It is uprooting sidewalks, walls or other structures.
- It is severely leaning or has dangerous and weak hanging limbs that threaten structures, mechanical units or lives.
- Requests for tree removals because an owner doesn't like the tree, the tree is overcrowding other trees or because grass will not grow beneath it and other similar circumstances will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

In any of the above events the MAC may require a replacement tree to be planted in place of the one that was removed. If the location of the tree that was removed is not suitable for a replacement, the MAC may require a replacement be planted at another location or arrangements may be made for a future replacement at a later date. An escrow of funds may or may not be imposed.

##### **PLANT SELECTION:**

The intent of the approved plant list is to provide a guide to plants that are consistent with the overall image of Gainey Ranch and do not create undo maintenance issues.

It should be noted while a plant may be on the approved list, not all plants are appropriate for all locations, and during the approval process, the Master Architectural Committee may deny approval even though the plant is on the approved list. Additionally, each Satellite community may have a more restrictive approved plant list that must be adhered to.

##### **GRCA LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT:**

The Master Architectural Committee offers the service of a Landscape Architect to the homeowners to assist in the selection and appropriate planting locations, the first meeting with the Landscape Architect is potentially free of charge to all homeowners and Associations.
